Mercy General Hospital, a not-for-profit hospital founded by the Sisters of Mercy, has been at its current site in the heart of East Sacramento since 1925.

It provides a wide range of health, social and support services with special advocacy for the poor and underserved.

The 342-bed facility includes the nationally recognized Dignity Health Heart & Vascular Institute and The Joint Commission-certified Stroke Programs. Mercy General, which leads the state in open-heart surgery, is accredited as a Certified Chest Pain Center with PCI, the first Sacramento-area hospital with this distinction.

It also houses the first CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities)-accredited Acute Rehabilitation Unit in the region. Additionally, Mercy General is a respected center for maternity care, orthopedics, spine care and oncology.

Mercy General's Alex G. Spanos Heart & Vascular Center is a state-of-art, four story addition that provides all cardiac services under one roof: Cardiac Rehabilitation, Cardiac Support Unit and Cardiopulmonary Services. It also includes:

- 71 private, family-friendly patient rooms
- Expanded 21-bed cardiac ambulatory procedure area
- A highly advanced 20-bed cardiac surgery ICU

among such prestigious institutions as Stanford, UCLA and UC San Diego.

Emergency Department: Staffed by the highest quality doctors and nurses, Mercy General Hospital is a community leader in providing open Emergency Room access, with service 24-hours-a-day, 7-days-a-week, far more hours than other downtown Sacramento hospitals. We accept ALL patients who need high-quality, affordable health services.

Neuroscience/Spine and Rehabilitation Services: Mercy General Hospital's philosophy of care is nowhere more evident than in our neuroscience, spine and rehabilitation services. To help patients manage their physical, mental and spiritual health, we look at the whole person rather than simply treating the illness or injury. Patients from throughout the greater Sacramento area have come to depend on Mercy's standard of health care excellence.

- Our biplane angiography suite is an important part of this care, with the ability to perform neurological interventional coiling.
