

## VOLUNTEERS HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Please obtain copies of your immunization/titer records **before** you schedule your initial visit with the employee health nurse, and bring the copies with you.

1) **TB Skin Tests** – A two-step TB skin test is required for all new volunteers (test one, followed by test two, given at least 7 days later with results read 48-72 hours following each application). If you have had a TB skin test within the past 12 months, please provide documentation. **Documentation must include: date and time applied, date and time read, and induration in millimeters.** Please make an appointment with Employee Health to get the TB testing completed. We also accept documentation of Quantiferon TB blood test done within the past 3 months.

**Positive TB Skin Test** – If you have had a positive skin test in the past, please provide documentation of the positive skin test. If you've had a chest x-ray done within the past year, bring that documentation to Employee Health.

2) **Measles (Rubeola), Mumps, and Rubella**

Documentation of the following is required:

- Two **Measles** (Rubeola) or **MMR** vaccinations or a **lab test** showing immunity to measles
  - Two **Mumps** or **MMR** vaccination or a **lab test** showing immunity to mumps
  - One **Rubella** or **MMR** vaccination or a **lab test** showing immunity to rubella
- If you have not received the **MMR vaccines**, they must be administered **after** TB skin testing is complete. **Vaccinations must be at least 28 days apart.**

3) **Chickenpox (Varicella)**

Documentation of two Varicella vaccinations or a **lab test** showing immunity to varicella

- If you have not received the Varicella vaccine, it must be administered **after** TB skin testing is complete. **Vaccinations must be at least 28 days apart.**

**NOTE:** for proof of immunity the lab/blood test should test for IgG antibodies. We require copies of the actual lab reports or physician documentation of immunity

4) **Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis Vaccine)**

1 booster dose of Tdap vaccine in the past 10 years (DTP, Td, DT and DTaP are not accepted)

5) **Hepatitis B** – Documentation of Hepatitis B vaccination series or documentation of lab test showing immunity to Hepatitis B. You may sign a Hepatitis B signed declination if you do not wish to be vaccinated and you will not be in patient care areas. Please see the Employee Health nurse to decline.

6) **Influenza (Flu) Vaccine** – Documentation of Flu vaccination or signed declination is required for all volunteers during the flu season – September through the end of March. Employee Health provides flu vaccination to volunteers free of charge.
