Technology and Technique

We offer other advanced wound care modalities including skin substitutes such as Epifix and many others. We combine these with Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT) to energize the body's natural wound-healing process.

In addition, our physicians have access to our SensiLase system to help determine with up to 90% accuracy, if wound healing is going to occur without surgical intervention. This advanced testing system is available only at the Center for Wound Care and Hyperbarics at Memorial Hospital. Negative pressure wound therapy and compression therapy are also available.
