Why we are different.

Low dose CT scan - Norton Thoracic Institute uses standardized protocols to minimize radiation risk.

Dedicated Chest Radiologist - Dedicated fellowship trained thoracic and oncology radiologists read results.

Free calcium scoring - Included with scans done at Dignity Health hospitals without any additional radiation dose or cost.

Multidisciplinary Tumor Board Review - Every CT scan is reviewed at a weekly meeting composed of pulmonologists, thoracic surgeons, oncologists, infectious disease physicians, thoracic radiologists, internal medicine /family medicine physicians and recommendations are provided.

Rapid communication of results - The recommendations of the multidisciplinary review are communicated to patients' primary care physician and the patient. The patients are offered a one-on-one visit with a Norton Thoracic Institute physician to go over all findings; all information is sent to the referring doctor.

Smoking Cessation and Lifestyle changes - We have a prospective database that has shown significant lifestyle changes with 85% of the active smokers having changed their smoking habits; culminating in a quit rate of almost 40%. In addition, 70% started exercising regularly and 36% adopted a low fat diet.
