
Saint Francis Memorial Hospital

Located atop Nob Hill and adjacent to the Tenderloin District, Saint Francis is home to one of the City's busiest emergency rooms, the Bothin Burn Center—the largest burn unit in Northern California as well as the Saint Francis Orthopedic and Sports Medicine Institute, and the Gender Institute. It's the first hospital internationally to achieve accreditation as a Center of Excellence in Gender Confirmation Surgery by globally-recognized Surgical Review Corporation—a nonprofit patient safety organization dedicated to recognizing and refining surgical care. With its close proximity to downtown San Francisco, Saint Francis also specializes in Occupational Health and Rehabilitation Medicine, and is a Certified Stroke Center by the Joint Commission.
