

## COVID TESTING AT ST. MARY'S MEDICAL CENTER

Patients experiencing a medical emergency, inpatients, and patients undergoing surgical/invasive/diagnostic procedures can receive COVID 19 testing as follows:

**NOTE:** Inpatients are admitted to the hospital via the Emergency Department, Surgery/Invasive Procedure Departments or as “Direct Admits” from the physician’s office, another facility, etc. Patients admitted via the Emergency Department are tested in the ED; patients admitted via Surgery/Invasive Procedure/Diagnostic Departments are tested 48-72 hours prior to their procedure at the Pain Clinic; patients admitted as “Direct Admits” are tested upon arrival to their assigned bed.

Test results are available 48 hours after sample collection.

There are no co-pay requirements for testing consistent with state and federal laws/rules.
