

SAVE PATIENTS FROM EXCESSIVE DRAWS

To prevent additional draws for patients, consider the following:

- Please assess the patient daily before ordering qAM labs orders.
- Use of qAM for multiple days are highly discouraged.
- Before requesting lab orders, check Cerner for existing lab tests.
- Use the “Lab Add On” feature if samples have been collected.
- Consider ordering qAM collection for next day if collections are completed for the day.
- When ordering after midnight for morning draws, order qAM labs as TIMED priority at 3:05 am.

Too many pokes ain't no joke!

- **Routine** – Next phlebotomy rounding collection which queues in the lab on the hour
- **STAT** – Clinically unstable or currently in OR or ED
- **Timed** – Request a specific time and frequency
- **ASAP** – Priority, patient is clinically stable (Infrequently used)

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Steps to Order Timed Labs

Fill in the following order entry fields:

1. **Date/Time:** Enter date and time of the first lab to be collected
2. **Collection Priority:** Timed
3. **Frequency:** Select frequency with interval designated – i.e. q12hr(interval)
4. **Duration:** Must enter a duration number
5. **Duration Unit:** Enter duration unit which correlates to duration time
6. **Label Comments:** Add further instructions or need to emphasize on the order
