Exposure to cancer treatment such as chemotherapy and radiation may lead to bone loss and increased the risk of osteoporosis and fractures. However, our bones are in a constant state of regeneration and renewal and can be strengthened. For good bone health, it is important to diagnose osteoporosis in its early stages. If needed, there are several medications that can be used to directly slow down the speed of bone loss. In addition, it is essential to signal the body to continue making new strong bone. Exercise—especially weight-bearing exercise such as walking, jogging and stair climbing—will help to slow down bone loss and is especially helpful in fall prevention.
