The original campus of the St. Rose system is celebrating its 75th year in southern Nevada, marking the 1947 date when seven Adrian Dominican Sisters arrived from Michigan to assume operation of the community's only hospital, a government facility slated for closure after World War II.

The Rose de Lima Campus is now one of three Dignity Health-St. Rose Dominican acute care hospitals in southern Nevada. From its inception in 1947 through today, the journey of St. Rose Dominican is one inspired by the timeless values of the Dominican Sisters of Adrian, whose remarkable legacy of service to the poor, sick and oppressed dates back centuries.

Today the Rose de Lima Campus remains a vital part of the Henderson community. Now a small hospital offering emergency services, diagnostic imaging, and inpatient services, the Rose de Lima Campus continues to provide care for all patients regardless of their ability to pay.

In the final stages of completing a major transformation, the Rose de Lima Campus remains committed to continuing the healing mission of Dignity Health at this historic location. The 24-hour Emergency Department and Inpatient Hospital continues to provide care for the downtown Henderson community, amidst recently renovated space which is now home to more than 100 members of the Dignity Health Nevada administration and support staff.

Walk the halls of St. Rose and feel the history that is the foundation of our community.

Fast Facts:

- The Dominican Sisters of Adrian purchased the hospital in 1947 for \$1 a year for 25 years. Their mission has continuously expanded and is now celebrating its 75th year as a leader in southern Nevada health care.
- The Rose de Lima Campus was originally built and operated by the U.S. government to service area plant workers and their families.
- The Rose de Lima Campus remains in its original location and has been in continuous operation, providing care for the Henderson community for 75 years.
- More than 100 Nevada Market support service staff work from the Rose de Lima campus, providing Compliance, Medical Records, Marketing & Communications and many other essential services.



- Rose de Lima is home to the Dignity Health Education Center for the Nevada Market. In addition to providing New Employee and New Leader orientation training, Clinical staff utilize the center for ongoing education and to maintain certifications.
- Rose de Lima hosts one of five Dignity Health Wellness Outreach Centers which provide life-long care for the entire family through a range of free and low-cost fitness and education classes.
- Dignity Health-St. Rose Dominican was recognized as one of the top 10 best employers in Nevada, as part of Forbes' annual list of America's Best-in-State Employers 2020.
