Description: The Dignity Health-St. Rose Dominican, San Martín Campus is the third St. Rose hospital facility in southern Nevada, specifically located to serve the rapidly growing area of southwest Las Vegas, including Rhodes Ranch and Mountain's Edge. Since 2006, San Martín has followed the foundation established by the Adrian Dominican sisters who arrived in Henderson more than seven decades ago, providing unparalleled care for the body, mind and spirit, and taking hospital care in southern Nevada to the next level.

The 147-bed, 30-acre campus includes a 24-hour, full-service Emergency Department, Surgical Suites, Cardiac Catheterization and Electrophysiology Lab, Diagnostic Imaging, Orthopedics, Cardiovascular and Neurologic Services, and a Wellness Outreach Center which offers life-long care for the entire family through a range of free and low-cost fitness and education classes.

San Martín Campus prides itself as a safe and comfortable place for families to grow. Consistently ranked by the readers of the Las Vegas Review-Journal in the Best Place to Have a Baby category of the Best of Las Vegas Poll, San Martín is also one of the only hospitals in southern Nevada with Laborists on duty 24/7, and Birthing Suites where mothers remain in the same room throughout Labor, Delivery, Recovery, and Post-partum.

San Martín has also earned the prestigious Baby-Friendly designation, demonstrating adherence to the highest standards of care for breastfeeding mothers and their babies, based on evidence-based practices recommended by the World Health Organization and UNICEF.
