Description: Building on a foundation of seven decades of unparalleled care for the body, mind and spirit in Henderson and Las Vegas, the Dignity Health-St. Rose Dominican, Siena Campus - our ministry's flagship Nevada hospital - celebrated the 20th year of its healing mission in July 2020.

Constantly growing and expanding to meet the medical needs of the community, the Siena Campus recently achieved accreditation as a Center of Excellence in Robotic Surgery, recognized for providing the highest quality of care and patient safety by Surgical Review Corporation, an independent, not-for-profit, organization administering best-in-class accreditation programs. Siena was the first Nevada hospital to achieve Center of Excellence in Robotic Surgery accreditation.

Siena is currently relocating and expanding its Pediatric Emergency Department, the only Pediatric ER facility in Henderson, Nevada's second largest city. When completed in 2023, the enhanced facility will feature nine dedicated Pediatric Emergency beds, separate Pediatric ER entrance, admitting, and waiting areas, and dedicated Pediatric ER parking.

In 2019 Siena added the Dignity Health Rehabilitation Hospital to its campus. The 60-bed, private room hospital offers the area's highest level of rehabilitation services for patients recovering from stroke, traumatic brain injury, amputation, neurological disorders, and spinal cord injury.

As Nevada's only not-for-profit, faith-based health system, Dignity Health-St. Rose Dominican has been guided by the vision and the values of the Adrian Dominican Sisters since 1947. For 75 years, as the Henderson and Las Vegas communities grow, the St. Rose Dominican health system and its nearly 4,000 employees continue the Sisters' healing mission of serving people in need.
