






Sequoia Adult Cardiovascular Surgery





Conclusion: Sequoia is above average for CABG, AVR, and AVR + CABG star rated domains, low volume preventing 3-Star Rating.



CABG Risk-Adjusted Operative Mortality



AVR Risk-Adjusted Operative Mortality




AVR+CABG Risk-Adjusted Operative Mortality






Importance of Volume for Star Ranking

STS AVR Composite Scores






STS CABG Composite Rating Across Affiliates/Alliances






STS AVR Composite Rating Across Affiliates/Alliances






STS AVR+CABG Composite Rating Across Affiliates/Alliances






STS MVR/MVr Composite Rating Across Affiliates/Alliances
