Catholic Healthcare West Contributes \$100,000 to Haiti Relief Efforts

San Francisco, CA – January 13, 2010 – Catholic Healthcare West (CHW), the eighth largest hospital system in the nation, announced today that it is making a corporate donation of \$100,000 to aid the victims of Haiti following the devastating magnitude-7 earthquake on Tuesday.

The not-for-profit hospital system has contributed \$50,000 to Catholic Relief Services to aid in meeting the immediate needs of the Haitian people, and another \$50,000 to Global Health Ministry to aid in the reconstruction of the Hospital St. Francis de Sale in Port Au Prince.
