Our maternity suites are beautifully furnished with soft colors, wood floors and coordinating bedding which offer a comfortable, yet highly functional and nurturing room for your stay.

Labor/Delivery/ Recovery

- **(LDR) Suites** These suites allow mom and her labor partner to remain in one room during all phases of the birthing process. Each suite includes a TV, private bath with shower and a resting chair for your labor partner.
- Birthing Beds These comfortable, yet highly functional beds convert to an upright position to allow the forces of gravity to help mom with an easier delivery.
- Surgical Suite Fully-equipped for Cesarean sections, this suite is located very close to our LDR suites, giving you the comfort of knowing that it can be accessed immediately if this should become necessary.
- Couplet Care Our suites are designed to give you special time with your baby who will remain with you during your stay.
- Kangaroo Care We encourage this preferred skin-to-skin bonding method named after the way a baby kangaroo nestles in its mother's pouch.

Our Level III-B Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) offers the most sophisticated care for babies born at any viable gestational age, including micropreemies.

New Neonatal Intensive Care Unit

Our newly designed NICU is twice as large as our previous NICU with private rooms where mom stays and bonds with her newborn. There's also sleeping accommodations for a parent or care partner, double-sized rooms to accommodate twins and lactation areas so mom can continually provide breast milk.

24-Hour Obstetrical Services

Board certified OB Hospitalists are on-site 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to provide expert care when a mother-to-be's obstetrician is unavailable or on the way to the hospital.
