

Patient Visitation Policies



ALL VISITORS MUST SHOW PROOF OF*:

- COVID-19 Vaccination *or*
- Negative COVID-19 Test (taken within the last 72 hours)

**Exemptions provided for end of life patients.*

NO VISITORS FOR:



- COVID+ Patients
- Infectious Isolation Patients

LIMITED VISITORS FOR:



- Inpatients
- Same Day Admits
 - 2 designated visitors.
 - Only 1 visitor will be permitted to visit at a time.



- Outpatient Procedures
- Outpatient Visits
 - 1 support person
 - Must stay in the waiting room / designated waiting area.



- NICU
- Pediatrics
 - 2 designated visitors at a time when capacity permits.



- Emergency Department
- Patients under the age of 18:
 - 1 legal guardian



- Family Birthing Center
 - 1 designated Birth Partner or Coach and Doula during labor & delivery*.
 - 2 designated visitors during post-partum recovery*.
 - Visitation during a C-section may be more restrictive.

** As room capacity permits.*



- Comfort Care
- Palliative Care
- Dementia
- Physical, Intellectual, Developmental Disabilities
- Cognitive Impairment
 - 2 designated support people
 - Only 1 visitor will be permitted to visit at a time.



Visiting Hours:
9 a.m. to 9 p.m.



Visitors will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms at entrances.



Visitors must be symptom-free and must wear a mask at all times regardless of vaccine or testing status.



Visitors should primarily stay in the patient's room.



No children under the age of 14.



Visitors must maintain physical distancing of 6 feet.



Additional patient visitation requests will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.



Visitation access and restrictions are applied regardless of individual characteristics as outlined in regulation including but not limited to sex, race, color, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression, marital status, age, registered domestic partner status, citizenship, or immigration status.

Compliance with the above guidelines is necessary for continued visitation.
