**Artie J. Cannon Helping Hands of Henderson** – Provides transportation services to those 60 and older for medical appointments, shopping and errands to help individuals maintain independence and live in their homes unassisted. 702.616.6554

**R.E.D. Rose** – A collaborative effort between St. Rose Dominican Hospitals and Susan G. Komen for the Cure, R.E.D. Rose provides breast exams, mammograms, ultrasounds, surgical consultations and biopsies and support services to women and men who lack adequate health care coverage or the financial means to obtain them. **WIC Program** – The Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program is a nutrition program that provides nutritious foods, nutrition counseling, nutrition classes, breastfeeding support and referrals to health and other social services to participants at no charge.
