



COVID-19 Vaccine Administration

Mercy Medical Group started patient vaccinations the week of January 11th at two locations and expanded to four locations the week of January 18th. We plan to continue our weekly vaccine clinics at Citrus Heights, Folsom, Midtown and Elk Grove. We have administered over 7,300 vaccines so far with plans to increase our capacity to 3,400 1st shots and 3,400 2nd shots per week—for a total vaccine deployment of 6,800 shots per week. We are proactively calling our primary care patients at all our clinic sites, and offering appointments at any of our 4 vaccine clinic locations. All of our MMG patients meeting our current vaccine eligibility criteria will have an equal opportunity to access vaccine appointments at our vaccine clinics.

What You Need To Know (updated February 12, 2021):

Prioritizing Vaccines and Contacting Patients

- We're prioritizing patients according to guidance from public health agencies.
- We are currently offering vaccines to Mercy Medical Group patients 65 years old.
- We will be proactively contacting Mercy Medical Group patients who meet these criteria to set up appointments.
- We are not currently offering vaccine appointments to those eligible according to their job/employment. We hope to assist with opportunities for these groups as our processes allow. At this time—our vaccine eligibility is according to age: 65 and older.
- We request that our patients who desire COVID-19 vaccination not call us to schedule a vaccination appointment at this time, unless we have contacted you by phone, text or email.

How it Will Work

- When we contact eligible patients to make an appointment, we will include instructions on where to go to receive the vaccine and we will also set a date and time for your second vaccine dose.

- Please allow for drive time to the location as well as up to 30 minutes after the vaccination to be monitored for any allergic reactions.

What is Next

- We will continue to post updates on this website, including when we are able to offer appointments to more age groups.
- We hope to eventually provide online scheduling opportunities, and will provide those updates here. This is just the start of what we hope will culminate in making vaccine available to everyone in our community who desires it.
- Mercy Medical Group is also partnering with Dignity Health, UC Davis, and Hill Physicians Medical Group to offer community vaccination opportunities for the underserved and other populations. To date, we've participated in vaccine clinics at Cristo Rey High School and Sacramento City College.
