

COVID-19 Vaccine Administration

Dignity Health Medical Group – Sierra Nevada began patient vaccinations on February 5th. We are vaccinating our medical group patients according to vaccine supply and local federal and state guidelines. **Patients must have an appointment before coming to the vaccination location.**

What You Need To Know (updated February 20, 2021):

We have a limited number of vaccine appointments.

Current Vaccination Group

- We have a limited number of vaccine appointments available and we are prioritizing patients in accordance with guidelines from health agencies.
- We are now vaccinating **established patients who are 65 and older**. Other groups will follow according to federal and state guidelines.
- At this time, we are unable to give vaccinations to community members who are not established patients.*

How It Will Work

- We will be proactively contacting Dignity Health Medical Group – Sierra Nevada patients who meet these criteria to set up appointments.
- We respectfully request that our patients who desire COVID-19 vaccination not call us to try to schedule a vaccination appointment at this time. We will be reaching out by phone to qualifying patients as our vaccine supply allows.

Vaccination Details

- When we contact eligible patients to make an appointment, we will include instructions on where to go to receive the vaccine and we will also set a date and time for your second vaccine dose.
- Please allow for drive time to the location as well as up to 30 minutes after the vaccination to be monitored for any allergic reactions.

What is Next

- We are committed to distributing vaccines as equitably and broadly as possible in accordance with prioritization guidelines from health agencies.
- We will continue to post updates on this website, including if and when we are able to offer appointments to more age groups.
- We hope to rapidly scale the deployment of the vaccine and expand it to a larger number of patients as soon as possible.
