#### Dignity Health Neurological Institute of Northern California:

The Dignity Health Neurological Institute of Northern California offers the expertise of neurological specialists at Mercy San Juan who provide breakthrough treatments for complex diseases that affect the brain, including stroke, epilepsy, multiple sclerosis, brain tumors, advanced neurovascular therapy, spine and brain trauma.

Mercy San Juan Medical Center has been certified by The Joint Commission as a Center of Excellence for knee and hip replacements as well as being *the first California hospital north of the Bay Area to be designated as a Comprehensive Stroke Center by The Joint Commission.*

#### Dignity Health Heart & Vascular Institute:

Mercy San Juan's cardiac program includes cardiac surgery, cardiac catheterization and cardiac rehabilitation. A third cath lab offers the latest technology, with a focus on peripheral vascular disease. The team ranks among the nation's best in getting patients from the Emergency Room to the procedure they need in the fastest time. Blue Cross/Blue Shield has named Mercy San Juan a Blue Distinction Center for Cardiac Care.

## Services

**Bariatric surgery:** Mercy San Juan is recognized as a Bariatric Surgery Center of Excellence by the American Society for Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery and supports people who are considering surgical weight loss as a means to help them reclaim their life, health and well-being.

**Family Birth Center/Level III NICU:** At Mercy San Juan, 3,000 babies are born each year in the Family Birth Center. Premature or seriously ill newborns receive excellent care in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). Our 26-bed Level III NICU is ranked among the world's elite for survival rates of premature infants.

**Hyperbaric Oxygen (HBO):** Mercy San Juan provides hyperbaric oxygen therapy to treat patients with tissue damage from radiation therapy, carbon monoxide poisoning, slow-healing wounds and gangrene.

**Level II Trauma Center:** Mercy San Juan Medical Center has achieved Level II Trauma Center verification from the American College of Surgeons continuously since 2000. Trauma centers provide comprehensive specialized care to seriously injured patients through prompt access to trained physicians and staff and specialized services, all available 24 hours a day.

**Lung & Esophageal Center:** The Lung & Esophageal Center at Mercy San Juan offers a comprehensive approach to evaluating, diagnosing and treating individuals with known or suspected diseases of the lungs, chest or esophagus. Our sophisticated surgical techniques and specialized level of care represent one of the largest and most advanced programs of its kind in Northern California.

**Mercy Sleep Center:** Accredited by the American Academy of Sleep Medicine, the Sleep Center offers the latest digital technology and doctors who are board certified in sleep medicine to help treat sleep disorders including sleep apnea, narcolepsy, periodic limb movements and insomnia.

**Orthopedic services:** Mercy San Juan's orthopedic surgeons and expert staff provide patients with effective treatment solutions to restore strength, flexibility and function to major joints such as knees, hips and shoulders. Treatment for joint pain caused by arthritis or injuries to ligaments or tendons ranges from physical therapy to joint replacement surgery to rehabilitation. The MAKOplasty® robotic surgical system offers patients the option of minimally invasive partial knee resurfacing, rather than total joint replacement. Mercy San Juan and sister hospital Mercy General Hospital are the only hospitals in the region to offer this revolutionary technology.

**Dignity Health Cancer Institute:** The Dignity Health Cancer Institute of Greater Sacramento provides a gateway to quality cancer care. Our team of board certified medical oncologists, surgeons, radiation oncologists and cancer specialists are all supported by specially-trained cancer nurses and nurse navigators, pharmacists, nutritionists, home health nurses, hospice nurses, palliative care specialists and spiritual care experts. They work closely together to maximize effectiveness in treating even the most complex cases. We also offer the latest in radiological and nuclear technology, as well as full laboratory services.

**da Vinci Surgical System:** Mercy San Juan added the daVinci Surgical System, enabling its busy existing robotic surgery program to expand to two robots and to meet growing community needs and provide the latest advancements in minimally invasive surgery. Our comprehensive robotic surgery program includes colorectal surgery, general surgery, gynecology, gynecologic oncology, thoracic and urology. This minimally invasive approach for many complex surgical procedures provides patients with smaller incisions, less bleeding and quicker recoveries.
