Building on the Medicare Advantage star rating system for health plans, the IHA collects performance data and assigns star ratings to 181 physician organizations based on how well they provided recommended care in 2016 to more than two million California seniors and people with disabilities enrolled in Medicare Advantage health maintenance organizations (HMOs).

“Our team is honored to be among the top-third of medical groups statewide,” said Dr. Karen Hopp, MD, President at Woodland Clinic Medical Group. “To receive a 4.5-star recognition from the IHA is a significant achievement and testament to the importance we place on delivering high quality, compassionate care that puts our patients at the center of everything we do.”

Clinical quality measures used to calculate the star ratings range from rates of breast and colorectal cancer screenings, to eye exams and blood sugar control for patients with diabetes, to managing osteoporosis in women with a previous fracture. Collecting these measures at the physician organization level allows IHA to combine data from the six participating health plans to identify performance variations and target quality improvement efforts.
