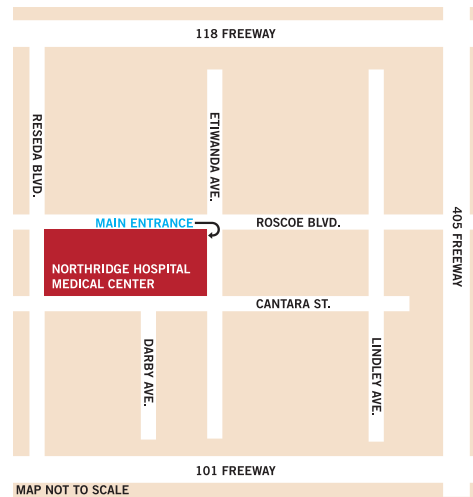

Childbirth Education Series

This is a four-class series that can be joined at any time. The series includes the Breastfeeding Workshop and Pain Management during Labor/Cesarean Childbirth classes. Registration is recommended by the sixth month of pregnancy.

Breastfeeding Workshop

As a Baby Friendly Hospital, Northridge Hospital has adopted practices that support breastfeeding. This class, taught by a Certified Lactation Educator, provides pregnant women and new mothers with the information to encourage a successful breastfeeding experience.

In addition, studies show that when partners and grandparents are supportive of breastfeeding it increases a mother's confidence and ability to breastfeed.
