

California State University Long Beach Full Scale Active Shooter and Mass Casualty Exercise

FRIDAY, AUGUST 9, 2019



This exercise will test the CSU Long Beach Police Department and Student Health Center's ability to respond to and recover from an active shooter incident or similar mass casualty event. It will test the University's emergency notification system and overall crisis communications plan, including the activation of a Joint Information Center. It will also test the procedures of our Unified Command structure with outside responding agencies and policy-level decision making of campus Administration.

Supporting agencies for this exercise include: Long Beach Fire Department, Long Beach Police Department, Dignity Health St. Mary Medical Center, VA Medical Center of Long Beach, American Red Cross, Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), and the City of Long Beach Department of Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Communications.

1. **Victims:** Volunteers are needed to play victims (patients) and witnesses/survivors. Patients will be moulaged for realism. Any volunteers inside the casualty zones will be given protective gear as simunitions will be used for this exercise.
2. **Exercise Evaluators:** Evaluators are placed in exercise areas to assess and document the performance and decision making of exercise Players.
3. **Support Roles:** Volunteers are needed outside of exercise "Play" areas to assist with perimeter security, victim moulage, and volunteer sign in.
