CHW Named One of the Best Places to Work for Fourth Consecutive Year

Health system ranks among top companies in the Bay Area for quality of work environment

SAN FRANCISCO – May 5, 2008 – For the fourth year in a row, Catholic Healthcare West (CHW) has been recognized as one of the Best Places to Work in the San Francisco Bay Area, among companies with 3,000 or more employees. The rankings were announced this week and will be published today in a special edition of the *San Francisco Business Times*, *Silicon Valley/San Jose Business Journal and East Bay Business Times*. To be eligible for the distinction, at least 8 percent of a company's employees had to respond to an online survey, comprised of 37 questions measuring employee satisfaction across 10 different categories, including: team effectiveness, retention risk, alignment with goals, trust with co-workers, individual contribution, manager effectiveness, trust in senior leaders, feeling valued, work engagement and people practices.

"We value our employees for who they are, not just what they do," says Ernie Urquhart, CHW's senior vice president/chief human resources officer. "Rewarding and investing in our staff is the most important thing we can do as an employer. They feel empowered and respected in their work, which supports them in providing excellent, compassionate care to our patients."

By offering some of the best employee reward programs in the country, CHW is able to attract and retain some of the best professionals in the healthcare field. In addition to employer-paid dependent health-care coverage and tuition reimbursement credits, CHW offers a wide variety of leadership, managerial and mentoring programs that provide employees with the knowledge and resources to improve their skill sets.
